

Hi Louise,

We no longer service the equipment for John Grose, but have in the past. The last service and inspection carried out by AGM Services was in July 2011.

The two questions you raise as you know are the statutory requirements for the Dust Extraction System and a Spraybooth Oven under HSG-258, and I can confirm that the equipment as originally installed would have been commissioned to work at those levels, and subsequently throughout the period that AGM Services looked after the equipment it conformed as required, but can't comment on any service work or legislative testing since our last visit.

Hello,

I have recently undertaken an inspection of the spray booth activity at the above site and I understand your company services the booths and filters etc. I met with Paul Forder who was able to provide me with most of the information necessary although he suggested I contact you about a

couple of queries. I wondered if you would be kind enough to provide me with the following information:

1. The emission limit for particulate matter [dust] shall not exceed 10mg/Nm³. Please confirm that the Junair TD500 extraction system meets these requirement.
2. The efflux velocity of the spraybooth discharge vent shall not be less than 15 metres per second. Please confirm that this is the case.
