

IPSWICH MARKET ACT 2004

Ipswich Market (Cornhill and Princes Street) Prohibition of Traffic Order 2018

Ipswich Borough Council acting in pursuance of its powers under Section 5 of the Ipswich Market Act 2004 and considering it both necessary and expedient to do so has made the above Order to regulate traffic on part of Cornhill and Princes Street in Ipswich.

The effect of the Order, which comes into force on 1st November 2018, is to prohibit motor vehicles on that part of Cornhill between the junction with Tavern Street and the junction with Princes Street and on that part of Princes Street between the junction with Cornhill and the junction with King Street in both cases between the hours of 8.30am and 4.30pm on any day on which the market is being held. Exemptions shall apply as shown in the Order.
