

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## UK Parliamentary Election for IPSWICH Constituency

1. An Election is to be held for **one** Member of Parliament to serve Ipswich.
2. Forms of nomination for the Parliamentary Election may be obtained at Grafton House, 15-17 Russell Road, Ipswich, Suffolk, IP1 2DE from the Acting Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, Grafton House, 15-17 Russell Road, Ipswich, Suffolk, IP1 2DE on any (working) day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 7th June 2024.
4. The required deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or, with the Acting Returning Officer's consent, in any other manner (including by debit or credit card or the electronic transfer of funds.)
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> July 2024.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Grafton House, 15-17 Russell Road, Ipswich, Suffolk, IP1 2DE by 5 pm on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2024. 8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Grafton House, 15-17 Russell Road, Ipswich, Suffolk, IP1 2DE by 5 pm on Wednesday, 26<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Applications can be made online: [www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote](http://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote).
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Grafton House, 15-17 Russell Road, Ipswich, Suffolk, IP1 2DE by 5 pm on Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> July 2024. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26<sup>th</sup> June 2024. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have
